Dear Ms. Pope:

The NMOCD has reviewed the submitted Stage 1 Final Investigation Report and Stage 2 Abatement Plan (AP-66) and draft Public Notice, dated October 24, 2007, for the above referenced site. The NMOCD hereby conditionally deems the Stage 2 Abatement Plan (AP-66) administratively complete.

Please keep in mind that the NMOCD cannot approve of the Plan until at least 30 days after you have provided public notice (which must be provided within 15 days). However, to expedite the approval process, the NMOCD recommends that the following amendments are made to the Plan:

1. The Corrective Action to the Groundwater must include that a groundwater recovery well will be installed downgradient of the Rice EME Jct. N-5 Site. An existing groundwater monitoring well may be used for this purpose. Also, please propose a treatment and / or disposal method of the recovered groundwater.

Also, the NMOCD hereby conditionally approves the Public Notice for the Stage 2 Abatement Plan (AP-66):

1. Please add the underscored phrase in the last line of the submitted draft Public Notice, "...Division shall allow at least thirty (30) days after the date of publication of this notice during which written requests for a public hearing that includes reasons why a hearing should be held and written comments may be submitted to him."
