Re: Administrative application on behalf of the operator, Apache Corporation, to drill its proposed Lockhart "A-17" Well No. 8 as a replacement Grayburg oil well location within a former standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Penrose Skelly (Grayburg) Pool (50350) comprising the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 17, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, at an unorthodox oil well location 1480 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of Section 17.
