Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated July 22, 1993, for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Hanks Well No. 16E which was drilled in June 1982 and completed in the Basin Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 1520 feet from the North line and 1725 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Dakota zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, Lots 6, 7, 10, 11, 12 and 13 and the E/2 SW/4 (W/2 equivalent) of said Section 6 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 349.33-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
