Dear Mr. Jacobs:

Reference is made to your application dated January 6, 1994 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Okie Well No. 1 which was drilled in 1977 and completed in the Potwin-Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 1105 feet from the South line and 840 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 8, Township 24 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, the S/2 of said Section 8 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
