Dear Mr. Verquer:

Reference is made to your application dated January 27, 1994, for a non-standard oil well location for the existing State "B" Com Well No. 233-R (API No. 30-039-25328) located 945 feet from the North line and 1830 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 16, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The E/2 NW/4 of said Section 16 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 80-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1), the Special Rules and Regulations for the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-1191, as amended and Division Memorandum 4-86, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
