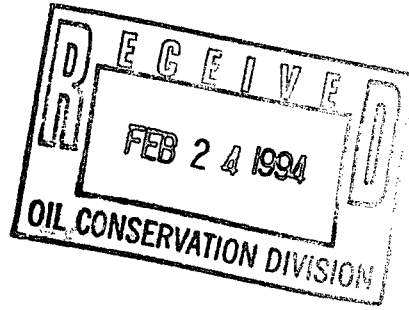

Meridian Oil Inc. is applying for administrative approval of a non-standard location for the above location in both the Mesa Verde and Dakota formations. This application for the referenced location is due to terrain as shown on the topographic map and archaeology.

This well is planned as a Mesa Verde/Dakota dual, and application will be made to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division to dual this well.

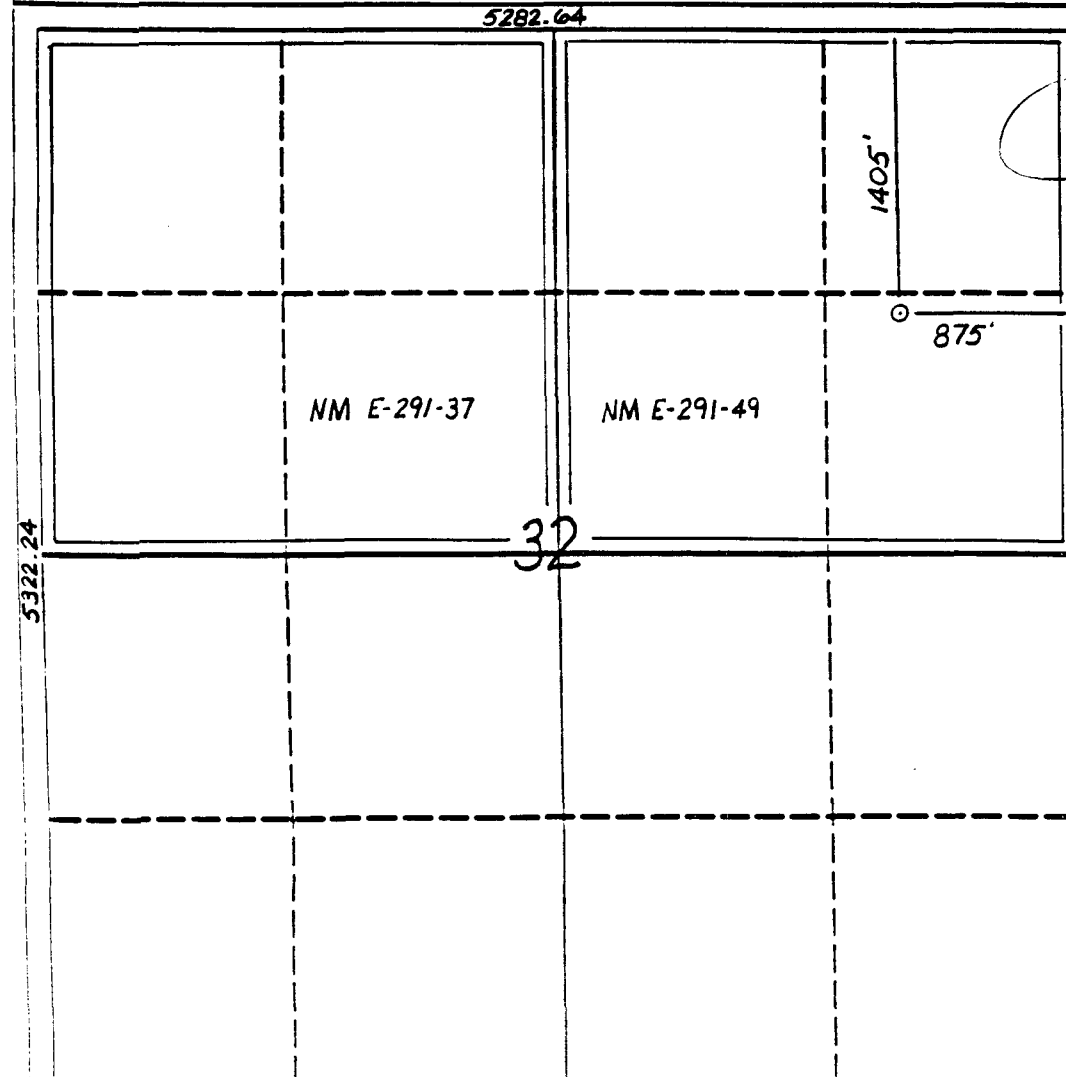

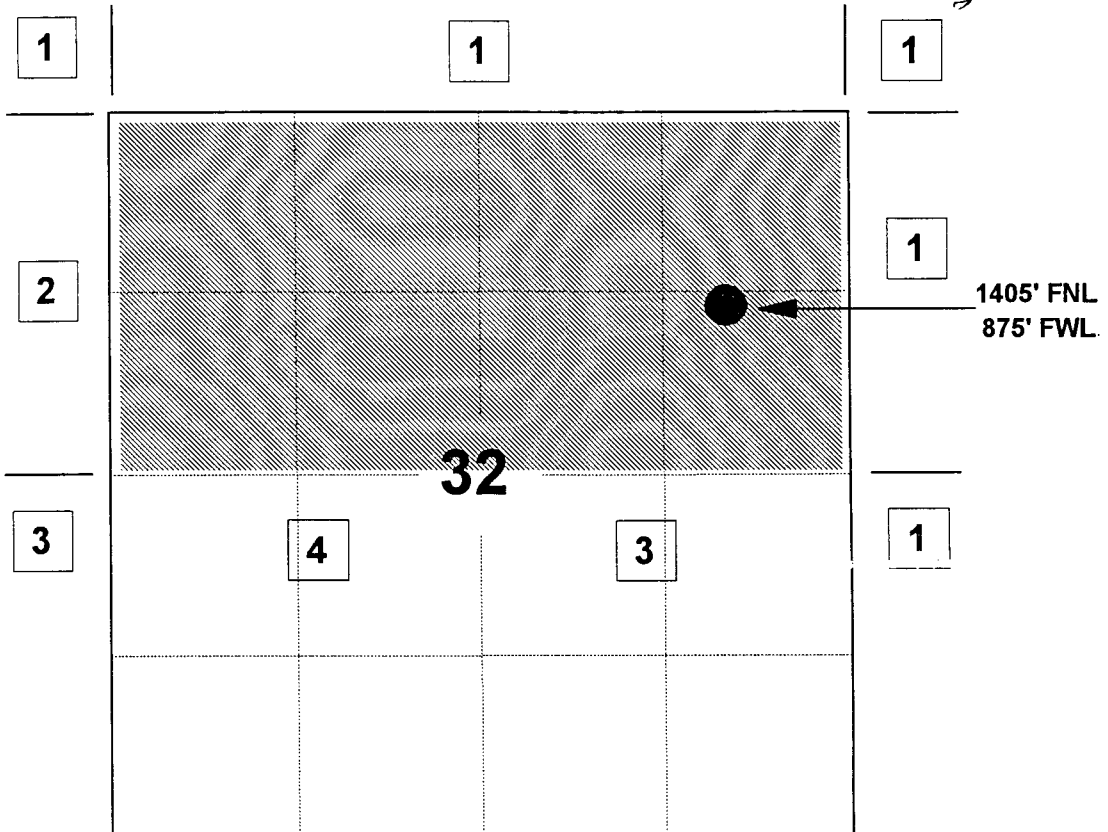

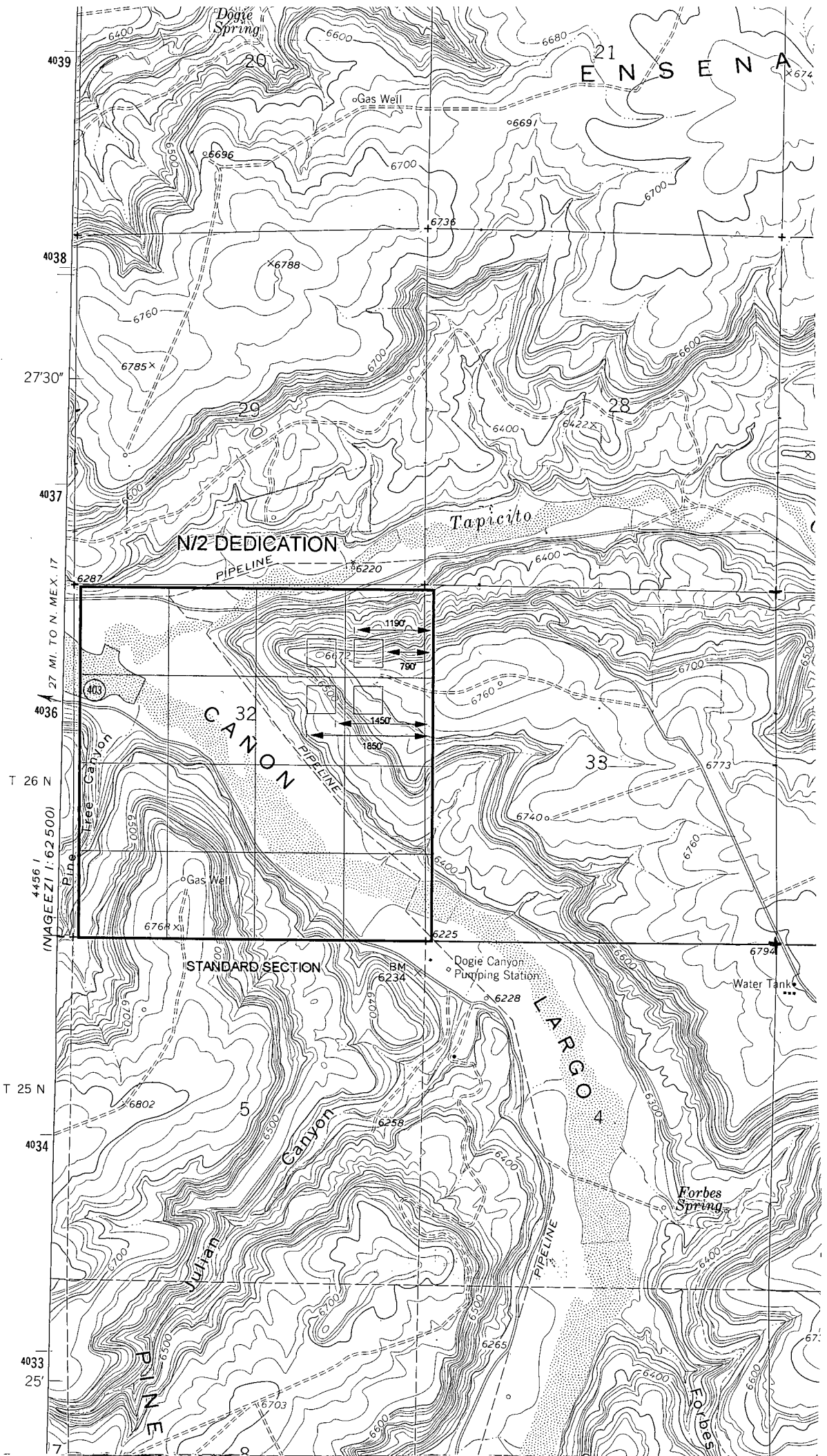
