

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated March 11, 1994, for a non-standard gas well location for San Juan 29-7 Unit Well No. 92-R to be drilled 450 feet from the South line and 2025 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 16, Township 29 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Blanco Mesaverde Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The W/2 of said Section 16 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
