Reference is made to your application dated April 19, 1994, for a non-standard oil well location for your E.C. Hill "B" Federal Well No. 11 to be drilled 1125 feet from the South line and 520 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 35, Township 23 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Teague-Devonian Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The SW/4 SW/4 of said Section 35 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
