Dear Mr. Benson:

Reference is made to your application dated July 7, 1994, for a non-standard gas well location for the proposed Rincon Well No. 149-E to be drilled 1900 feet from the North line and 1365 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 30, Township 27 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, to test both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The existing 319.08-acre gas spacing and proration unit comprising Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 and the E/2 W/2 (W/2 equivalent) of said Section 30 for both pools currently dedicated to the UNOCAL Rincon Unit Well No. 149 (API No. 30-039-06868), located in Unit N of said Section 30 shall be dedicated to said well.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
