

Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated July 8, 1994, for a non-standard gas well location for C.M. Morris Well No. 100 to be drilled 1340 feet from the North line and 1405 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 10, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The NE/4 of said Section 10 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
