Reference is made to your application dated September 7, 1994 for a non-standard coal gas well location for your Bowers Well No. 90 to be located 790 feet from the South line and 2435 feet from the East line (Unit O) of Section 17, Township 24 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, Basin Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The S/2 of said Section 17 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
