Reference is made to your application dated August 8, 1994, for a non-standard gas well location for your Largo Spur "A" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-039-25056) located 1870 feet from the South line and 800 feet from the West line (Lot 3/Unit L) of Section 18, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Undesignated Ballard Pictured Cliffs Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Lots 3 and 4 and the E/2 SW/4 (S/4 equivalent) of said Section 18 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 159.54-acre gas spacing and proration unit.
