Dear Mr. Stogner:

In response to your letter dated January 5th (attached) asking for more detail regarding the non-standard location of the above well, we chose the location of this well to optimize sweep efficiency for possible future secondary recovery operations. We envision a potential 5-spot waterflood pattern centered on the Lentini Federal 1-15 with the Lentini Federal 1-1, 1-2, 1-3, and 1-5 as offset producers. The unorthodox 1-15 well is located equidistant from each of these offset wells. Because secondary recovery operations in the Brushy Canyon Formation of the Delaware Mountain Group are unproved, we proposed this well in an unorthodox location to promote maximum sweep efficiency and provide a higher probability of economic success for a potential waterflood pilot. Since the Lentini Federal 1-15 encroaches only on Chevron operated wells within the Lentini Federal lease, we foresee no potential correlative rights violations.

Dear Mr. LeMay:

Chevron U.S.A. proposes to drill the Lentini Federal 1-15 at a non-standard location in the East Herradura Bend (Delaware) Oil Pool. The location of the proposed well is 1000' FNL and 1125' FWL in Section 1, T-23-S, R-28-E, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The proposed well location is on an existing standard 40 acre East Herradura Bend oil proration unit and is non-standard only with respect to the quarter-quarter section line within Chevron's Lentini Federal lease. Production from this proration unit is currently assigned to the Lentini Federal 1-1. We respectfully request your approval of this non-standard location and the simultaneous dedication of production from both wells in the unit.

A copy of this administrative application was provided to our offset operators via Certified Mail. Attached is a map and a Form C-102 plat illustrating the proration unit acreage and well location. Also included is a copy of the letter sent to our offset operators.

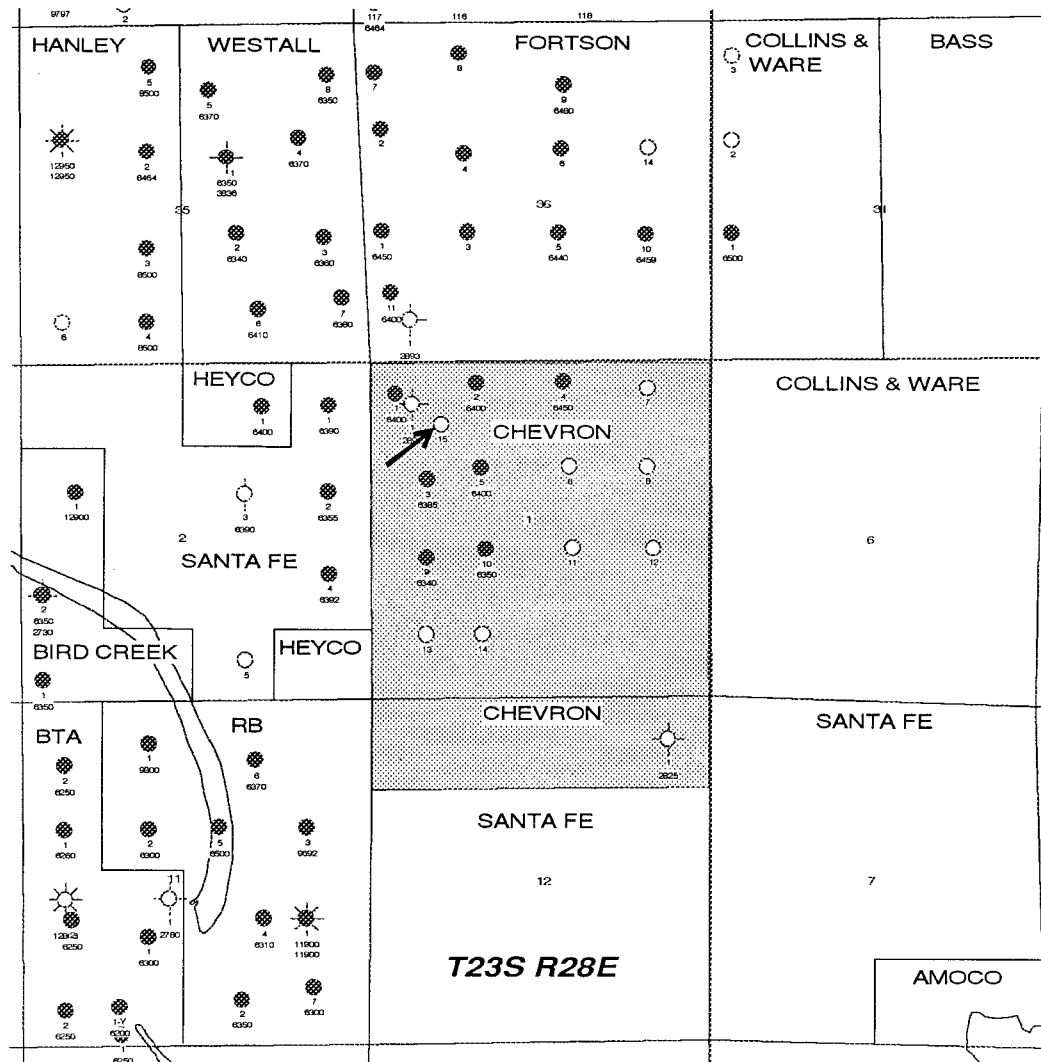

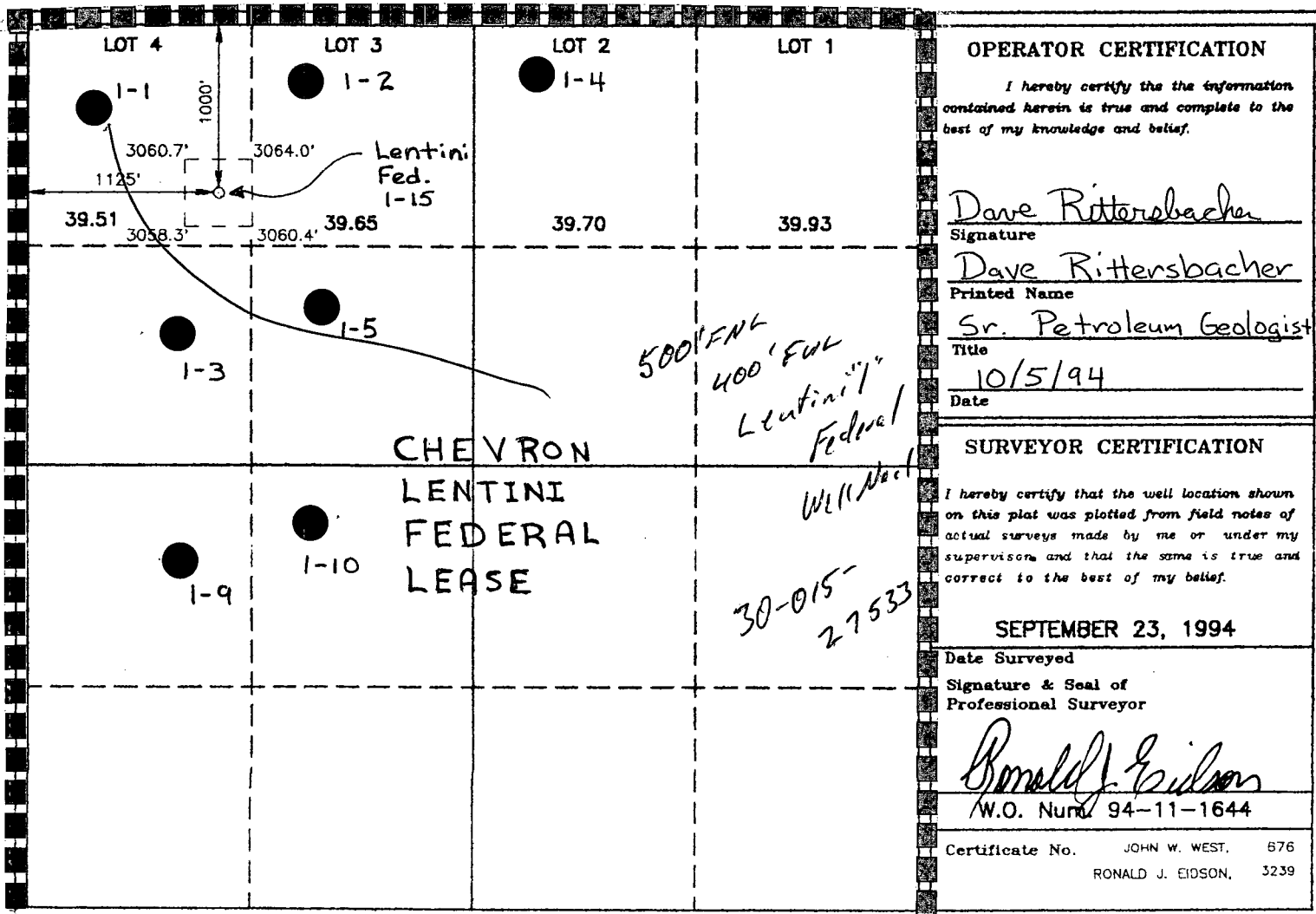
