Reference is made to your application dated February 1, 1995 for four unorthodox oil well locations for the purpose of completing an efficient injection/production pattern within both of Texaco's (Reserve) Cooper Jal Langmat and (Reserve) Cooper Jal Jalmat Waterflood Projects, established by Division Order Nos. R-4019 and R-4020, respectively, both orders dated August 25, 1970.

These four wells are to be located either in Sections 13 or 24, of Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Langlie-Mattix and Jalmat (Oil) Pools, Cooper Jal Unit Area, Lea County, New Mexico.
