Dear Mr. Buttross:

Reference is made to your application dated February 23, 1995 for an unorthodox oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the West Red Lake Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3469, dated August 13, 1968.

It is our understanding that the proposed West Red Lake Unit Well No. 47 is to be drilled 2310 feet from the North line and 1510 feet from the East line (Unit G) of Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Red Lake-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pool, West Red Lake Unit Area, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said well to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SW/4 NE/4 of said Section 8 which is currently dedicated to the West Red Lake Unit Well No. 23 (API No. 30-015-00822), located at a standard oil well location 1650 feet from the North and East lines of said Section 8.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of General Rule 104.F(1) the above-described unorthodox well location is hereby approved.
