Reference is made to your application dated March 24, 1995 on behalf of the operator, Northwest Pipeline Corporation, for an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool for the proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 72. Said well to be drilled 2315 feet from the South line and 620 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
