Dear Mr. Bullock:

Reference is made to your application dated April 27, 1995 for three unorthodox Abo gas well locations within your Salt Creek Unit Area, established by Division Order No. R-9442, dated February 19, 1991.

It is our understanding that the surface management agency, the U.S. Bureau of Land Management, has requested the three subject wells be moved to the proposed unorthodox well locations as to minimize surface disturbance in the area.

These three wells are to be located in Township 8 South, Range 22 East, NMPM, Salt Creek Unit Area, Chaves County, New Mexico.


