Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated October 10, 1995 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Jicarilla 120 "C" Well No. 14 (API No. 30-039-06275) which was drilled in 1957 and completed in the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 790 feet from the South and East lines (Unit P) of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the Pictured Cliffs interval will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, the E/2 of said Section 30 shall be dedicated to the well to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
