Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated August 23, 1995 for a non-standard Blanco-Mesaverde gas well location 1650 feet from the South line and 720 feet from the East line (Lot 1/Unit I) of irregular Section 10, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, for your existing Zachry Well No. 40 (API No. 30-045-25469), which was drilled at a standard oil well location in 1982 and completed in the Armenta-Gallup Oil Pool.

It is our understanding that the Gallup interval has recently been plugged back and said well has been recompleted to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and, pursuant to the "General Rules For The Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations For The Blanco-Mesaverde Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, said location is unorthodox. Further, all of said irregular Section 10 being a non-standard 259.20-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool is to be dedicated to said well.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 2(a)4 and 2(d) of said special pool rules, the above-described unorthodox gas well location and non-standard proration unit are hereby approved.
