Dear Ms. Byers:

Reference is made to your application dated January 22, 1996 for a non-standard oil well location for the purpose of completing an efficient production/injection pattern within the Turner "A" (Lease) Grayburg-Jackson Waterflood Project Area, established by Division Order No. R-3185, as amended by Order Nos. R-3185-A, R-3528, and R-3528-A.

It is our understanding that the proposed Turner "A" Well No. 52 (**API No. 30-015-28795**) is to be drilled 1335 feet from the South line and 110 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Grayburg-Jackson Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Said well is to be dedicated to the existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 18, which is currently dedicated to the Turner "A" Well No. 13 (**API No. 30-015-05216**), located at a standard oil well location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 18.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104.F(2) of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division"), revised by Division Order No. R-10533, issued by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 11,351 on January 18, 1996, the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
