## Administrative Order NSL-3664(NSP)

Dear Mr. Thompson:

Reference is made to your application dated March 26, 1996 on behalf of the operator, Williams Production Company of Salt Lake City, Utah, for an unorthodox gas well location in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool for the proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 160. Said well to be drilled 1250 feet from the South line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit O) of irregular Section 25, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Lots 3 and 4, the SW/4, and the W/2 SE/4 (S/2 equivalent) of said irregular Section 25 being a non-standard 272.32-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool is to be dedicated to said well.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location and non-standard gas spacing and proration unit are hereby approved.
