
Reference is made to your application dated July 15, 1996 on behalf of the operator Santa Fe Energy Resources, Inc. for a non-standard oil well location for the proposed Grassland "27" Well No. 1 to be drilled 1243 feet from the South line and 353 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 27, Township 15 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The geologic interpretation submitted with this application indicates that a well drilled at the proposed unorthodox oil well location will be at a more favorable geologic position within the Devonian formation than a well drilled at a location considered to be standard within the proposed standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 27.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division"), revised by Division Order No. R-10533, issued by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 11,351 on January 18, 1996.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(2), the above-described unorthodox oil well location is hereby approved.
