Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated November 11, 1996, for a non-standard Basin-Dakota infill gas well location in an existing standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") for the Basin-Dakota Pool comprising the W/2 of Section 17, Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, which currently has dedicated thereon the Whitley "A" Well No. 2 (API No. 30-045-06475), located at a standard gas well location 990 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of said Section 17.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of "General Rules For The Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations For The Basin-Dakota Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

Whitley "A" Well No. 2-E 1050' FNL - 1230' FWL (Unit D)

Further, Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company is authorized to dedicate Basin-Dakota gas production on the subject GPU from both the Whitley "A" Nos. 2 and 2-E. Said wells and GPU will be subject to all existing rules, regulations, policies, and procedures applicable to prorated gas pools in Northwest New Mexico.
