

#### II. Background

Safety and Environmental Solutions, Inc. (SESI) was engaged by Americo Energy Resources to perform cleanup services at the East Shugart Unit #56 spill site. On November 19, 2007 an injection value failure caused a release of approximately 200 barrels of produced fluids. A vacuum truck was utilized to recover 145 barrels of produced water and 5 barrels of oil.

#### III. Surface and Ground Water

The closest groundwater of record is in Section 34 of the same Range and Township. The depth of water in this well was 261' in March of 1994.

#### IV. Work Performed

On May 21, 2008 SESI began remediation of the contaminated areas according to the approved workplan dated February 25, 2008. The entire spill area was excavated to a depth of 4'. Approximately 1,360 cubic yards of soil were transported to Lea Land, an NMOCD approved facility, for disposal. The bottom of the excavation was then lined with a 20-mil impervious liner to prevent and further migration of contamination left in place. The entire area was then backfilled using like soils and contoured to grade. Windrows were also installed to help with re-vegetation and the area was reseeded.



It is requested that the spill report be closed with no further remediation required.


