## Administrative Order NSL-3851

Dear Mr. Noah:

Reference is made to your application dated July 17, 1997 for an unorthodox coal gas well location for the proposed San Juan "32-7" Unit Well No. 228 to be drilled 2628 feet from the North line and 1436 feet from the East line (Unit G) of irregular Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. The previously approved 317.23-acre gas spacing and proration unit (see Division Order No. R-9305, issued in Case 10058 and dated September 27, 1990) comprising: (i) that portion of tract 54 in Section 6; and, (ii) Lots 6 and 7, the SW/4 NE/4, the N/2 SE/4, and that portion of tract 54 lying in Section 7: all in Township 31 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, is to be dedicated to said well.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
