("Chesapeake"), pursuant to the provisions of Special Pool Rules for the Eumont Gas Pool, hereby seeks administrative approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit for the EW Walden Well No. 8 to be recompleted in the Queen formation from a location 2280 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line in Section 15, Township 22 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

This non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is necessary for geologic reasons. Attached as **Exhibit A** is a drainage bubble map for the EW Walden Well No. 8. As the map shows, the well is projected to drain approximately 100 acres. The EW Walden No. 6 located in the NW/4 NW/4 of Section 15 produces from the Queen formation and has drained 100 acres. 




