Dear Mr. Thompson:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division received your written request on November 10, 2003, to increase the allowable surface injection pressure on this disposal well. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on this well on November 3, 2003. After reviewing test results, we feel an increase in injection pressure is justified at this time.

With size and type of tubing remaining 2 7/8 inch, you are authorized to increase the surface injection pressure to a maximum of 1,025 psi.

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected water is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
