## Administrative Order NSL-4011

Dear Mr. Corcoran:

Reference is made to your application dated April 8, 1998, for an unorthodox gas well location in both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools for your proposed San Juan "32-5" Unit Well No. 13-M to be drilled 1711 feet from the South line and 1295 feet from the East line (Unit I) of Section 25, Township 32 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The E/2 of said Section 25 is to be dedicated to said well in order to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for both intervals.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool/Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Pool," as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described unorthodox gas well location in both the Blanco-Mesaverde and Basin-Dakota Pools for the San Juan "32-5" Unit Well No. 13-M is hereby approved.
