Reference is made to: (i) your application dated April 14, 1998; (ii) the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's ("Division") initial response to said application by letter from Mr. Michael E. Stogner dated April 21, 1998 requesting additional supporting data; (iii) your telephone conversation with Mr. Michael E. Stogner, Engineer with the Division in Santa Fe on April 24, 1998; (iv) your letter dated April 27, 1998 supplementing this application; and, (v) the records of the Division in Santa Fe: all of which refer to SDX Resources, Inc.'s request for an unorthodox oil well location in the Shugart-Yates-Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg Pool for the proposed Culwin "35" Federal Well No. 4 to be drilled 1040 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 35, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 35 is to be dedicated to said well in order to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for said pool.

The subject application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F.
