Reference is made to your recent application for an exception to 19.15.12.9A NMAC to permit the above-described well to commingle production from the subject pools in the wellbore.

It appearing that the subject well qualifies for approval for such exception pursuant to the provisions of Division Rule 12.11A, and that reservoir damage or waste will not result from such downhole commingling, and correlative rights will not be violated thereby, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production as described above and any Division Order which authorized the dual completion or otherwise required separation of the zones is hereby placed in abeyance.

In accordance with Division Rule 12.11A.(6), the production attributed to any commingled pool within the well shall not exceed the allowable applicable to that pool.

Assignment of allowable to the well and allocation of production from the well shall be as follows.

LOVINGTON; GRAYBURG-SAN ANDRES Pool	Pct Gas: 98	Pct Oil: 92
Undesignated LOVINGTON;PADDOCK Pool	Pct Gas: 2	Pct Oil: 8

These percentages shall be amended only with written permission of the Division.

REMARKS: The operator shall notify the Hobbs District Office of the Division upon implementation of commingling operations.

Pursuant to Division Rule 12.11B., the commingling authority granted herein may be rescinded by the Division Director if conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
