EDI Environmental Services, Inc. (EDI) is pleased to provide the following information concerning EDI's site visit on July 11th, 2007 and the completion of recommendations noted in the reviewed June 2007 Phase I Site Assessment performed by AEI.

During the initial site visit (July 2007) EDI noted visual hydrocarbon staining present around the AST containment area and recommended a remediation be performed to limit the migration of the hydrocarbon fluids. As the majority of the stained area laid above asphalt, EDI recommended removing the accessible soils and spreading a loose absorbent material ("Floor Sweep") over the remaining areas to be removed and disposed once saturated. EDI then recommended applying a bio-enhancer product to the affected area to expedite the natural degradation of any remaining contamination.

Remedial Activity Summary: (AST Area Tract C)

As per the attached Photo – 1, Knight Oil tools has removed the accessible soils and applied "Floor Sweep" over the remaining affected areas. The removed material is currently being profiled for disposal by Controlled Recovery, Inc. (CRI) located in Hobbs, NM. Once saturate, the remaining material will also be containerized in 55 gallon steel drums and disposed by CRI.

EDI is currently comprising an SPCC plan within the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPP) for this facility. As per the New Mexico Oil Conservation District (OCD) an SWPP should be kept on-site and renewed every 5 years.

Drum / AST Consolidation: (Future Construction on acquired property)

It is understood by EDI that a new containment area is to be constructed upon acquiring the adjacent property. EDI will re-evaluate the containment area when completed and prepare the appropriate SWPP / SPCC plan updates. EDI also understands all AST's and drums will be consolidated within the new containment area.

Any remaining hydrocarbon contamination around the former AST and/or drum storage area will be remediated upon the consolidation of the containers.

Suspect Underground Storage Tank: (Tract C)

The suspect UST was exempt from NMED UST Regulations as per NMED Title 20 Ch. 5 Part I.C. (1) (2) (4) and (7). The UST in question was formerly used as part of a "Flow-thru Process System" by Baker Atlas Wireline, a previous tenant.

The UST was removed to eliminate any future subsurface liabilities.


