

Marbob Energy Corporation, Post Office Box 227, Artesia, New Mexico, 88211-0227, has filed Form C-108 (Application for Authorization to Inject) with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking administrative approval to re-enter the Pick State No. 2 locatted 2310' FSL 2310' FEL, Section 23, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and convert it to a salt water disposal well in the Delaware Sand and dolomite formation from 5909' to 6420'. The maximum injection rate will be 2000 BWPD at a maximum surface injection pressure of 1151 psi. Injection water will be sourced from area wells producing from the Delaware, Atoka and Morrow formations. The disposal water will be injected into the Delaware Sand and dolomite. Any interested party who has an objection to this must give notice in writing to the Oil Conservation Division, 1220 South Saint Francis Street, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87505, within fifteen (15) days of this notice.
