
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* On 12/15/08 @ 1000 hrs. at the MCA Well 321 located 3 miles South/East of Maljamar, NM, an accidental discharge of \leq 60 bbls. of brine based drilling mud w/ skim oil was released from a temporary storage tank. 30 bbls. were recovered.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Affected area 25'x 150'. The contaminated soil in this area were removed and hauled to a controlled facility. The floor and walls of the contaminated area were sampled. This process continued until the analytical were within N.M.O.C.D. guidelines. Clean backfill was then put in place and copied to the natural slope of the surrounding area. Then a B.L.M. approved seed mixture was thin applied to the soil and tilled with a tractor.
