RE: Application for Administrative Approval of Unorthodox Location Primero Federal #1 - 850' FNL and 847' FWL

Section 23, T-26S, R-24E, Eddy County, New Mexico

Dear Mike:

Marbob Energy Corporation (Marbob) hereby makes application pursuant to Oil Conservation Division Rule 104.F.(2) for administrative approval to drill the above referenced Primero Federal to the Morrow formation based on geologic/surface considerations.

Marbob proposes to drill the Primero Federal #1 well at an unorthodox location 850 feet from the north line and 847 feet from the west line in Section 23 of Township 26 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The proposed proration unit is the north half and this would make the location have greater than the standard setback of 660 feet but be unorthodox to the west setback by 803 feet.

Marbob is the operator for the well with the rights in the lease being owned by Marbob Energy Corporation and Primero Operating, Inc. The spacing unit which this well will encroach upon is either the N/2 of Section 22 of Township 26 South, Range 24 East or the E/2 of Section 22 of Township 26 South, Range 24 East depending on where the location was placed. There are

currently no deep wells in Section 22 so no proration units have been established. Marbob Energy Corporation and the other owners listed above own the same interest in the N/2 and SE/4 of Section 22 of Township 26 South, Range 24 East under the same federal lease NM-100316. We have identified all adjoining proration units on Exhibit "B" with a list of the owners or operators for each tract. Each party listed has been notified and supplied with a copy of this application.

Exhibit "A" is a plat showing the proposed unorthodox well location and the spacing unit for the Primero Federal #1. The spacing unit is outlined in orange. We initially selected an orthodox location to the south and east. Upon our initial review, it was determined that that location was a fairly severe slope. We then moved the location further south and east up on fairly level terrain. Upon inspection of this location by the BLM, we were advised that this location fell in three special management areas - sensitive soils, cave karst, and visual. The BLM identified some sinks near the proposed location and turned it over to their geomorphologists. Their cave specialists met our people on location and he objected to the location based on a series of sinks near the location. He and our people spend the remainder of the day reviewing the area for karst and looking for alternative locations which agreeable both to our geologist and their cave person. They finally settled on an alternate location at 2123 feet from the south line and 1744 feet from the west line. I objected to that location because it was closer to a sink than the original location. After a lengthy meeting with the BLM, it was apparent that they were not going to approve our original location. In the field survey of this area, the cave person for the BLM had also agreed that the location submitted with this application was suitable to drill. We finally determined that to achieve two locations in that section, we should agree to their location 2123 feet from the south line and 1744 feet from the west We submitted our application to drill at that location. The BLM proceeded to do an EIS on the location. After the 30 day waiting period, we began punching up the application to determine when it would be approved. They advised us that without consultation they had decided to move our location to the west. That was unacceptable to us for geologic reasons. The BLM indicated that any other location would be burdened with significant additional requirements which would render tremendous additional cost to Marbob. We asked our people to go back to the field to review the area again to determine if an other acceptable geologic location could be found which would get us away from the sinks. They spend the better part of the day reviewing the are and found more sinks without finding a good location. As a result, we finally requested that the BLM approve the location contained in this application. They have approved the location which is submitted herein.

We affirm that notice has been sent to the offset operators or lease owners. We would request that you consider approval of this unorthodox location. Thank you for your help in this matter. If you have any questions, please contact me.





Yates Petroleum holds the position that the operator should be allowed discretion with regard to the appropriate field development density by providing for multiple wells within a spacing unit in cases where offsetting correlative rights will not be impaired. Increasing the flexibility of an operator to match the development density to the geology and well performance will increase the recovery efficiency on a per acre basis resulting the total volume of gas and condensate recovered from a given pool.
