Reference is made to your application dated February 3, 1999, which was received by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's ("Division") office in Santa Fe on February 11, 1999, for a non-standard Wolfcamp gas well location for Enron Oil & Gas Company's proposed Brininstool "4" State Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-34571) to be drilled 660 feet from the South line and 1890 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Undesignated Johnson Ranch-Wolfcamp Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Lots 3 and , the S/2 NW/4, and the SW/4 (W/2 equivalent) of Section 4 being a standard 319.62-acre stand-up gas spacing and proration unit for this pool is to be dedicated to the well.

The geologic interpretation submitted with this application indicates that a well drilled at the proposed unorthodox gas well location will be at a more favorable geologic position within the Wolfcamp formation than a well drilled at a location considered to be standard for this 319.62-acre unit.

The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104.F(2), the above-described unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
