Marbob Energy Corporation (Marbob) hereby makes application for approval of an unorthodox well location in the Yeso formation in the Foster-Eddy Federal Well No. 13 located 1295 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West Line of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. The NE/4 NW/4 of Section 17 is dedicated to the well. Accordingly, this well is orthodox from the West line of the dedicated spacing unit, but encroaches on and is unorthodox to the South line of the spacing unit by a distance of 305 feet. The Oil Conservation Division previously granted an unorthodox well location in the San Andres formation in the same well (See Administrative Order NSL-3718(SD) attached hereto as Exhibit "A"). Marbob drilled and completed the well in late 1996 and early 1997.

Marbob originally sought approval of this unorthodox location in the San Andres formation to efficiently drain additional reserves in the SW/4 NE/4 NW/4 of Section 17 that otherwise would not be produced thereby causing waste. This unorthodox location was based on a cumulative oil production map of the Grayburg and San Andres formations (as designated in 1996). A reproduction of

that map is attached hereto as Exhibit "B". As you will see, on this map only Grayburg-San Andres producers (as designated in 1996) are shown. production from wells drilled prior to 1970 is shown in green while oil production from wells drilled after 1990 is shown in red. Pre-1970 wells were normally drilled at a well density of 1 well per 40 acre proration unit. Cumulative oil production from pre-1970 wells in the immediate area ranged from 50,000 barrels of oil to almost 400,000 barrels of oil (Avg.=136,000 BOPW). After 1989, several wells were drilled in this immediate area by both Marbob and Avon (predecessor to Devon). Significant additional oil reserves were obtained as a result of this infill drilling. In the E/2 NW/4 of Section 17 over 188,000 barrels of oil had been recovered from the infill drilling program, which is only 52,000 barrels less than was recovered by the original two wells drilled on this 80 acre tract. No infill wells had been drilled in the SW/4 NE/4 NW/4 and the N/2 NE/4 NW/4 of Section 17. The location for the Foster-Eddy Federal Well No. 13 was situated to efficiently drain the remaining reserves in the SW/4 NE/4 NW/4 by moving away from the No. 4 and the No. 6 wells thereby preventing waste.

As Marbob is also the operator and lessee of record of the SE/4 NW/4, the proposed unorthodox location only encroaches on Marbob's own leasehold interests. There is no notice required for offset spacing units that are not encroached upon under current rules. Thus, no offset leaseholders were given notice.

All of the lands on the Foster-Eddy Lease (shaded orange on attached Exhibit "D") are Federal minerals having common ownership. Marbob is the lessee of record of these lands. Since the working interest and royalty interest ownership across the lands affected by the proposed unorthodox location are common, the unorthodox location will not impair correlative rights of any mineral owner in the affected lands in either the San Andres or Yeso formations. The map also shows current Yeso producers in green and red.

In the E/2 NW/4 of Section 17 over 188,000 barrels of oil had been recovered from the infill drilling program, which is only 52,000 barrels less than was recovered by the original two wells drilled on this 80 acre tract. No infill wells had been drilled in the SW/4 NE/4 NW/4 and the N/2 NE/4 NW/4 of Section 17. The location for the Foster-Eddy Federal Well No. 13 was situated to efficiently drain the remaining reserves in the SW/4 NE/4 NW/4 by moving away from the No. 4 and the No. 6 wells thereby preventing waste.

The Foster-Eddy Well No. 13 was drilled through the Grayburg-San Andres formations and into the Yeso formation. The reasons for the unorthodox location in the Yeso formation are the same as the reasons for the unorthodox location in the Grayburg-San Andres formation. Attached hereto as Exhibit "C" is a section of the Neutron-Density Log from the well which shows the Yeso formation and perforations in the well.

Marbob is operator and lessee of record of the NE/4 NW/4 of Section 17. The spacing unit which is encroached upon by this well is the SE/4 NW/4 of Section 17. As Marbob is also the operator and lessee of record of the SE/4 NW/4, the proposed unorthodox location only encroaches on Marbob's own leasehold interests. There is no notice required for offset spacing units that are not encroached upon under current rules. Thus, no offset leaseholders were given notice.

All of the lands on the Foster-Eddy Lease (shaded orange on attached Exhibit "D") are Federal minerals having common ownership. Marbob is the lessee of record of these lands. Since the working interest and royalty interest ownership across the lands affected by the proposed unorthodox location are common, the unorthodox location will not impair correlative rights of any mineral owner in the affected lands in either the San Andres or Yeso formations. The map also shows current Yeso producers in green and red.

Marbob respectfully requests that the Oil Conservation Division administratively approve the unorthodox location of the Foster Eddy Well No. 13 in the Yeso formation as well as the San Andres formation. If you have any questions concerning this matter, please contact me at 575-748-3303.



Reference is made to your application dated September 17, 1996 for an unorthodox Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres oil well location in an existing standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for the Grayburg-Jackson (Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres) Pool comprising the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Grayburg-Jackson oil production from said unit is currently simultaneously dedicated to the Foster Eddy Well No. 6 (API No. 30-015-25981), located at a standard oil well location 990 feet from the North line and 2310 feet from the West line of said Section 17, and to the Foster Eddy Well No. 8 (API No. 30-015-26187), located at a standard oil well location 330 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line of said Section 17.

The geologic interpretation submitted with this application indicates that a well drilled at the proposed unorthodox oil well location will be at a more favorable geologic position within its Foster Eddy leases to adequately drain reserves within the productive interval that might not otherwise be produced and to provide for a more efficient production pattern within the Grayburg-Jackson (Seven Rivers-Queen-Grayburg-San Andres) Pool.

The subject application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 104.F of the General Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division"), revised by Division Order No. R-10533, issued by the Oil Conservation Commission in Case 11,351 on January 18, 1996.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division General Rule 104.F(2), the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox "infill" oil well location in said Section 28 is hereby approved:


