Reference is made to the following: (i) your initial application dated April 15, 1999; and (ii) the records of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in Santa Fe ("Division") including the file in Case No. 12189: all concerning BTA Oil Producers' request to drill its proposed Grama "C" 8817 JV-P Well No. 1 at an unorthodox Morrow gas well location 660 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of Section 16, Township 22 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The S/2of Section 16, being a standard 320-acre lay-down gas spacing and proration unit for the Undesignated Grama Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool, is to be dedicated to this well.

The geologic interpretation submitted with this application indicates that a well drilled at the proposed unorthodox gas well location will be at a more favorable geologic position within the Morrow formation than a well drilled at a location considered to be standard within the SW/4 of Section 16.
