Dear Ms. Cermin:

We are in receipt of your letter of February 4, 2004 requesting our approval to surface commingle the gas produced from the Eagle "4" State Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-32569), Falcon "10" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-32571), Red-Tailed Hawk "10-H" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-32773), Peregrine "10" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-32312) and the Shrike Fed "10-H" #1 (API No. 30-015-32914) at the Birds of Prey Gas Gathering System. It is our understanding that the oil will not be commingled and the gas will metered using an orifice meter (calibrated quarterly) before leaving the well tank battery.

Since it appears that all the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division's rules and regulations have been complied with, and there will be no loss of revenue to the State of New Mexico as a result of your proposed operation, your request is hereby approved. Our approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
