

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken. \*

A 20 inch gathering line had a leak and released gas and any produced liquids that were lying in the line. Line was repaired with clamp and 300 feet of pipe ordered to be replaced. When pipe is replaced area will be cleaned to meet OCD guidelines.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Targa replaced 1000 feet of pipeline with new poly pipe. Targa excavated and sampled the area of contamination. Targa removed all contaminated soil and hauled to an approved landfarm The excavation was backfilled with 936 yards of clean soil. The area was delineated and tested per OCD Guidelines
