Gentlemen:

This letter is in reply to Mr. C. M. Rieder's wire of June 23, 1955 to the undersigned concerning the status of the Continental Oil Company's State A-32 No. 4.

Our letter to you dated June 14, 1955 requesting that the State A-32 No. 4 be classified as a Jalmat oil well should be disregarded because we were unaware that your office in Hobbs had requested our Hobbs office to submit a request for a non-standard gas proration unit because the well had a gas-oil ratio of 256,890 cubic feet per barrel when tested on August 29, 1954 and reported on Form C-116 under date of September 21, 1954.

Therefore, it is respectfully requested that our letter of June 14, 1955 be disregarded and that the well be classified as a gas well in the Jalmat gas pool by reason

of the high gas-oil ratio. It is also requested that the well be assigned a non-standard gas proration unit as set out in our Mr. N. A. Rickman's application dated May 25, 1955.

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of Order No. R-520 for a non-standard gas proration unit for its State A-32 No. 4 well located 1980° FNL and 1980° FNL of Section 32, T. 22S- R36E., Lea County, New Mexico in the Jalmat gas pool.

The unit is proposed to consist of the S/2 of the NW/4 and the N/2 of the SW/4 of Section 32, T22S- R36E.

#### Gentlemen:

Continental Oil Company's State A-32 lease is comprised of 640 acres consisting of section 32-T22S-R36E, Lea County, New Mexico. There are six wells on this lease of which two, wells Nos. 2 and 3, are gas wells producing from the Jalmat gas pool. Wells Nos. 1, 4, 5, and 6 are oil wells which until recently were classified in the South Eunice oil pool.

Under the provisions of order No. R-520 of the Oil Conservation Commission, wells Nos. 1, 5, and 6 were re-classified as Jalmat oil wells. Well No. 4, apparently inadvertently, was left in the South Eunice pool so that there is an apparent violation of statewide rule 303. According to our interpretation,

well No. 4 produces from the vertical limits of the Jalmat pool and should be re-classified as such.

It is respectfully requested that the Commission staff re-examine the data on this well and upon a determination that said well is actually producing from the vertical limits of the Jalmat pool said well be re-classified as a Jalmat oil well.
