Gentlemen:

By this letter of application, The Texas Company wishes to state the following:

a. That the applicant has recompleted its William Weir Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the west line and 660 feet from the south line of Section 23, R-36E, T-19S, in the Eumont Gas Pool at a plugback total depth of 3925 feet.

b. That the applicant proposes to assign to this well a non-standard gas proration unit consisting of that portion of the William Weir Lease being  $1\underline{60}$  acres which lies within said Section 23 and being the  $\underline{E/2}$  SE/4, SW/4 SE/4, and SE/4 SW/4 of said section.



- c. That 160 acres of the said lease, being the W/2 NE/4 of Section 25 and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 26, R-36E, T-19S, has heretofore been assigned to The Texas Company's William Weir Well No. 1.

The Texas Company requests that a non-standard gas proration unit be approved for this well as soon as waivers are received from the above four companies.


