Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM  
SE/4 of Section 29

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your State "F" Well No. 1, located 660 feet from the East line and 1980 feet from the South line and in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5 (b), Section 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 160 acres. Please advise this office when the communitization agreement has been executed and approved.

Gentlemen:

The undersigned represents several banks  
and individuals who own mineral rights in Lea County,  
New Mexico.

Most of this property is leased to the Gulf  
and Texas Companies. The Gulf Oil Corporation is requesting  
gas pooling agreement on 120-acre tract in the S/E 1/4 of  
Section 29, T-19-S, R-37-E. They state that the Shell Oil  
Company has drilled a well on the other 40 acres of this  
1/4 section and that the Conservation Commission of the  
State of New Mexico has approved the Eumont Gas Unit  
consisting of the S/E 1/4 of Section 29 and has granted  
a 160-acre allowable to Shell's well.

It is our desire to cooperate with the  
development but since we are not familiar with the  
necessity of gas pooling agreements, I would appreciate
