Gentlemen:

Attached herewith is Shell Oil Company's application for administrative approval of a 160-acre, non-standard, gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool. As pointed out in the application we have solicited waivers from the operators as required by Order R-520. The waivers will be forwarded to your office when they have been properly executed and returned to us.

The proposed unit is jointly owned by Gulf Oil Corporation (75%) and Shell (25%). A joint operating agreement has been signed designating Shell as operator. The royalty owner in the NE/4 SE/4 of Section 29 is The State of New Mexico and we received formal approval from the State Land Commissioner to form the proposed unit on June 30, 1955. The remaining acreage in the SE/4 of Section 29 is patented land with Gulf owning the lease. Gulf is in the process of securing the necessary joinders from the royalty owners and we believe that they are reasonably certain of receiving the approval of the remaining owners.

We request the immediate approval of the subject application upon receipt of the required operator waivers. If for some unforeseen reason the royalty owners do not agree to the forming of the unit, the additional allowable granted, based on a 160-acre unit, can be deducted from the existing 40-acre unit for Shell State F-1.

We will keep you advised of our progress in this matter.


