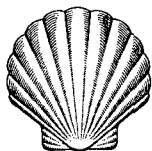

Under provisions of Commission Order No. R-520, Rule 5(b), delegating The Secretary - Director of the Commission authority to grant exception to the requirements of Rule 5(a) without notice and hearing for a non-standard gas proration unit, Shell Oil Company hereby applies for an exception to the aforementioned Rule for State F-1, Eumont Gas Pool.

In support of the above application, the following data are furnished:

Shell State F-1 is located 1980 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 29-19-S-37-E which is 660 feet from the east and north lines of the proposed unit. State F-1 was originally completed as an oil well with an initial potential of 96 BOPD from the open hole interval 3687 feet to 3943 feet. An application to recomplete as a gas-oil dual was made by NMOCC Form C-102, and was approved December 21, 1953. Subsequently, the dual completion operation was completed with the ~~Eumont gas zone producing interval~~ being 3490 feet to 3652 feet. After a 1000 gallon acid treatment, the subject well recorded a potential of 2600 MCFPD absolute open flow potential following which State F-1 was assigned a 40-acre allowable.

With regard to Rule 5(a), we wish to state the following:

(a) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit, comprising all of the SE/4 of Section 29-19S-37E, is composed of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.

(b) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit is wholly within a single governmental section.


(c) That the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.

(d) That the length and width of the proposed non-standard gas proration unit does not exceed 5280 feet.

(e) That the entire proposed non-standard gas proration unit is within the horizontal limits of the Eumont Gas Pool.

(f) That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interest in the section in which the non-standard gas proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit and all operators owning interest within 1500 feet of the well have been notified by registered mail of this application. In addition, each of the above operators has been sent a request for a waiver of notice and hearing on the subject application for exception to Order R-520.


