Wells 5,6,7 and 8 are Eumont oil wells open in the Queen in
same acreage as requested here. This dual completion is im-
proper as gas is perforated in Queen and oil in open hole is
Queen and Grayburg. Recommend disapproval until lowest gas
perforations are plugged(3634'-76') which are producing in wells

5,6,7 and 8- WWM
