Dear Mr. Mankin:

Please excuse our delay in answering your letter relative to application for non-standard gas proration unit for Pech-State well #1.

This well has been on test for the last several weeks. It now appears that it will be an oil well rather than a gas well. It is now producing about 75 barrels oil per day on a 16/64th inch choke with a gas-oil ratio of 785:1.

We probably will drill a second well on this tract within the next several months and attempt to complete it as a gas well from the upper part of the Yates. When this well is commenced we will make a new application for a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the SW/4 of Section 32, Twp. 21S, Rge. 36E. At that time we will be careful to make all of the requirements in the application.
