Continental Oil Company respectfully requests administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit for its Hawk B-3 No. 3 well located 1980' FSL & FEL of Section 3, T. 21S., R. 37E., Lea County, New Mexico in the Blinebry gas pool.


The unit is proposed to consist of lots 15, 16, 17, 18 of Section 3, T. 21S., R. 37E.

In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with Commission requirements in all respects as follows:

1. Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections (and/or lots).
2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 2,640 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished by registered mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well.

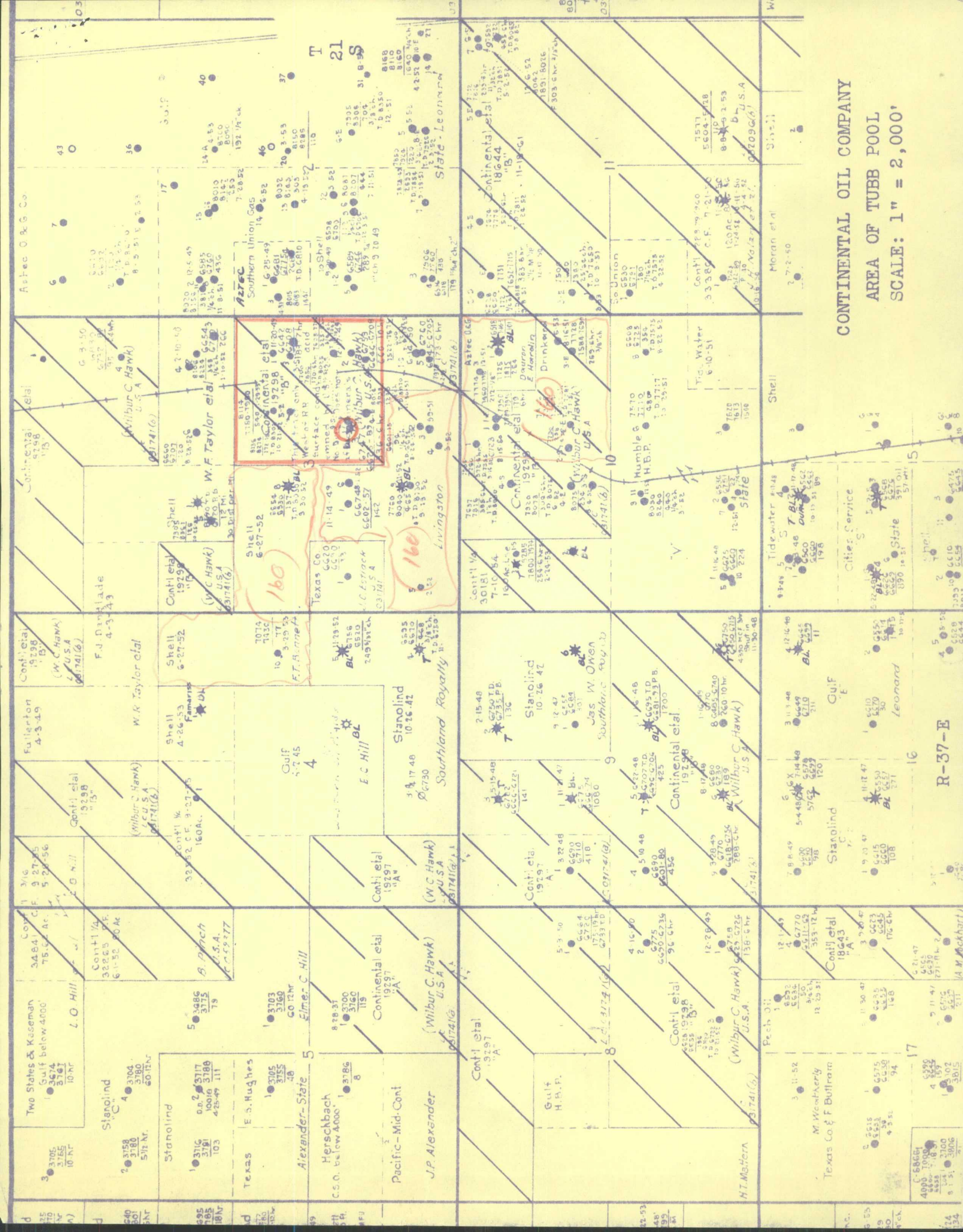
A plat is attached hereto showing to the best of our knowledge and belief, the proposed unit, the location of the well and the offset ownership.
