Reference is made to your letter dated October 26, 1955, requesting administrative approval for a 160-acre unit for your Seale (Federal) Well No. 2 in the Eumont Gas Pool. In that same letter you requested that the dual completion and 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit granted in Order R-555, dated December 16, 1954, for your Seale (Federal) Well No. 1, should be cancelled as it was never dualled and the same 160 acres or the SW/4 of Section 34, Township 20 South, Range 36 East, Eumont Gas Pool is to be assigned to your Well No. 2 under NSP-208 as granted on November 30, 1955.

Effective November 30, 1955, Order R-555 is rescinded for your Seale (Federal) Well No. 1 for a 160-acre non-standard gas proration unit and dual completion on said well and unit.

Gentlemen:

The Atlantic Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of NMOC Order No. R-520 for a non-standard gas proration unit for its Seale (Federal) No. 2 well which is a newly completed gas well located 1980' FS & WL of Section 34, T-20S, R-36-E, Eumont Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed non-standard gas proration unit is to consist of the 160 acres comprising the SW/4 of the described section.

In support of this request, it is pointed out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of the said Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

1. Said non-standard gas proration unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections.
2. Said non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
4. Neither the length nor width of the non-standard gas proration unit exceeds 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished by registered mail to all operators owning interest within the section in which this non-standard gas proration unit is situated, and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well.

In addition to conforming with said Rule 5 (b), forms G-104 and G-110, along with the required plat, have been filed with the NMCC in compliance with Rule 11 of Order No. R-520. A plat is attached hereto showing the proposed unit, the location of the well, and the offset ownership.

It is further requested that NMCC Order No. R-555, dated December 16, 1954, and granting, among other things, administrative approval for a non-standard gas proration unit to be assigned to the Seale (Federal) No. 1 well consisting of the SW/4 of Section 34, T-20-S, R-36-E, Ement Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, be rescinded. The Seale (Federal) No. 1 well was not dually completed in the gas producing zone as proposed and the non-standard gas proration unit approved for it in Order No. R-555 consists of the same acreage as the unit herein applied for to be assigned to the Seale (Federal) No. 2 well.
