## Gentlemens

The Atlantic Refining Company respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Ruls 5 (b) of NMOCC Order No. R-520 for a non-standard gas proration unit for its Seele (Federal) No. 2 well which is a newly completed gas well located 1980 FS & WL of Section 3h, T-205, R-36-E, Rumont Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
