Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 480-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Eumont Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM  
E/2 and E/2 W/2 of Section 26

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Meyer "A-26" Well No. 1, located 1980 feet from the North and East lines and in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Inasmuch as there are no offset operators, as specified in Section 5 of Rule 5 (b), it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 5, Section (b)-5 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Eumont Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 480 acres.
